



EMERGENCY CLOSURE OF PART OF RESTRICTED BYWAY FSB13 & PUBLIC FOOTPATH FSB10 (ST BRIAVELS PARISH) FOREST OF DEAN DISTRICT

Gloucestershire County Council, as traffic authority, has, by this Notice placed an emergency closure under the relevant provisions of Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) part of the Restricted Byway and the Public Footpath referred to in the Schedule below: -

Schedule

Restricted Byway FSB13 from its junction with Wyegate Lane at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) ST 55231/06407 extending in a generally southerly direction for approximately 900 metres to its junction with Stow Road at OSGR ST 55407/05579 and shown on the attached Map by a bold solid black line marked A to B to C to D.

Public Footpath FSB10, from its junction with FSB 8 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) ST 54579/05649 extending in a generally easterly and northerly direction for approximately 790 metres to its junction with Restricted Byway FSB13 at OSGR ST 55287/05932 and shown on the said Map by a bold solid black line marked E to C.

The said Restricted Byway and Public Footpath both fall within the Parish of St Briavels in the Forest of Dean District within the County of Gloucestershire.

The closure is necessary to safeguard the health and safety of the public due to a landslide and flood damage to the said Footpath FSB10 and Restricted Byway FSB13.

This Notice comes into force on **20th May 2024** and will continue for up to 21 days. If the works to remedy the problem have not been completed during this time scale, it will be necessary to either extend the closure, by Notice, for a further 21 days, and/or make a Temporary Closure Order.

If made, this Order will authorise the closure of the said Public Footpath and Restricted Byway for up to six months from the date of this Notice. If the problem continues after this time, it will be necessary to make an application to the Secretary of State for an extension to the closure.

Alternative Route – for pedestrians only, as shown on the said Map marked with a black dash line A to G to E and B to F on the said Map. Restricted Byway13 will be accessible for pedestrians only, between A to B on the said Map.

Emergency access, and pedestrian access to adjoining premises, will be maintained.
