- sometimes lead or actively support council led projects with the community

These responsibilities and duties are varied and utilise councillors' skills and experience to best advantage for their community.

You will be supported in your role as councillor and will be expected to undertake some training. You should have a positive outlook and a can-do attitude and be willing to work in a professional, pragmatic manner as part of a democratic team. Ideally you should be able to communicate well and be comfortable working electronically to receive council correspondence.

The **final deadline for return of application forms** is the midnight on **Sunday one whole week before the meeting date** and applicants will be considered at that next monthly council meeting, with successful co-optees taking immediate office once declaration papers are signed.
