

EMERGENCY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH FSB 36 (ST BRIAVELS PARISH) FOREST OF DEAN DISTRICT

Gloucestershire County Council has by this emergency notice closed temporarily under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) Footpath FSB 36 (St Briavels) from its junction with Public Footpath FSB 80 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 54348/03960 and then extending in a generally westerly direction for approximately 250 metres to its junction with Public Footpath FSB 37 at (OSGR) SO 54106/03994 and shown on the Map by a bold solid black line marked A to B

The Public Footpath falls within the St Briavels Parish in the Forest of Dean District, in the County of Gloucestershire.

The closure is necessary to safeguard the health and safety of the public due to damage to the path surface.

This Notice comes into force on the 27th August 2025 and will continue for up to 21 days. However, if the Public Footpath is required to be closed for a further period it will be necessary to either extend the closure by Notice for a further 21 days, or make an Order.

This legal Order, if made can authorise the closure of Public Footpath FSB 36 for up to six months from the date of this Notice. However, if the problem continues after this time, then it will be necessary to make an application to the Secretary of State for an extension to the closure.
